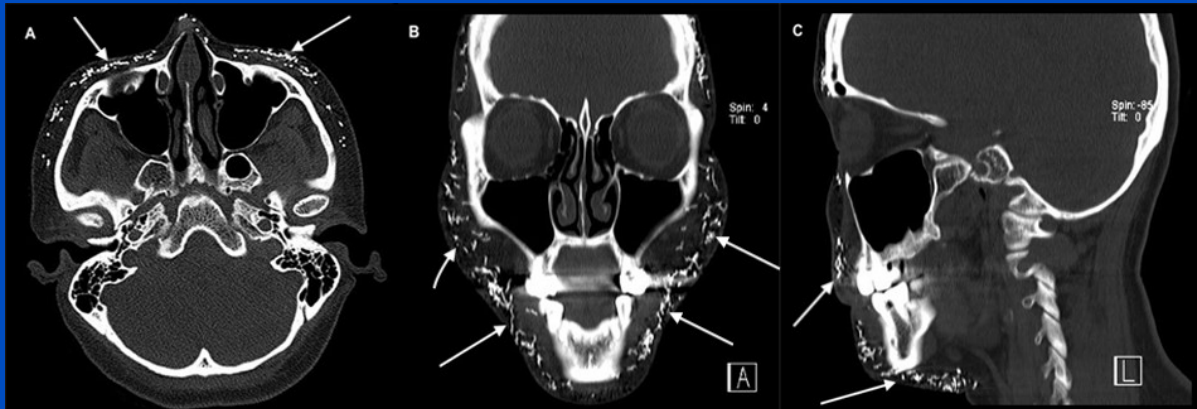


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These include controlled trials, interventional studies, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, outcome studies, cost-effectiveness analyses, and large-scale epidemiological studies. Manuscript should include the following; introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion. The objective should be stated clearly in the introduction. The text should not exceed 2500 words and references not more than 30.

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Case reports should highlight interesting rare cases or provide good learning points. The text should not exceed 1000 words; the number of tables, figures, or both should not be more than two, and references should not be more than 15.

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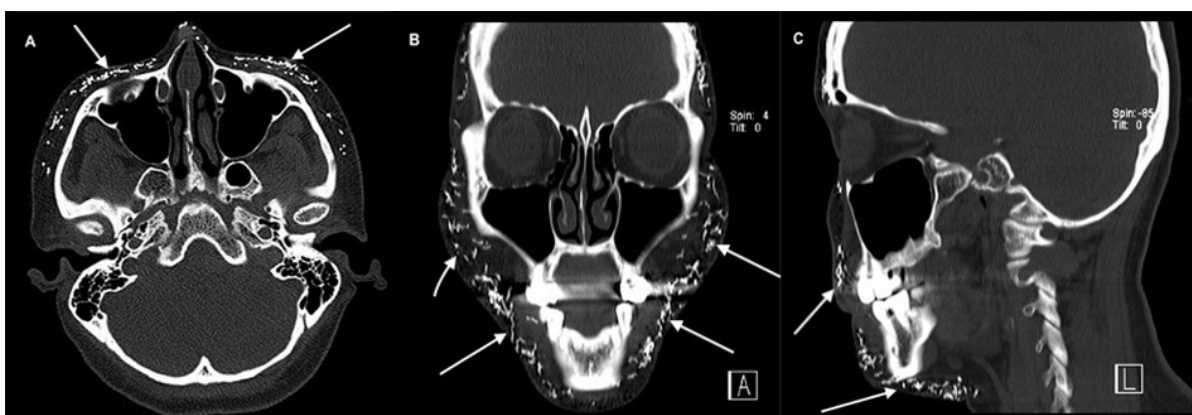

A 50-year-old lady presented to the otorhinolaryngology clinic with a 6-month history of intermittent facial pain and nasal blockage. Her medical history was notable for multiple visits to local beauticians for the treatment of facial wrinkles for the past 10 years. On examination, there were no swelling or scars on the face. Nasoendoscopy revealed inferior turbinate hypertrophy but was otherwise unremarkable. A high-resolution bone-window CT-scan of the paranasal sinuses was done due to the suspicion of sinusitis revealed normal sinuses. Multiple subcutaneous lightning-like radio-opaque shadows (Figure 1A and 1B; white arrows) involving the entire face and upper neck (Figure 1C; white arrows) were noted. (Click on image to enlarge)
